USF has produced 276 U.S. judges (including four California Supreme Court justices); a former United States senator; a California lieutenant governor; two Pulitzer Prize winners; four Olympic medalists; countless priests, nuns, and other religious leaders; educators; police chiefs; corporate CEOs and entrepreneurs; three NBA Hall of Famers; three NFL Hall of Famers; and Alejandro Toledo, the former president of Peru.
